## EQC Repairs Message from the Chair

Malvern Community Arts Council has recently been advised by Orion, who own the building which houses Selwyn Gallery, that earthquake repairs to the building are scheduled to take place in 2017.

Orion have requested that the Gallery be cleared prior to construction beginning on February 7<sup>th</sup> 2017. Selwyn Gallery will therefore have to temporarily close from 29<sup>th</sup> January 2017 to 13 March 2017. At this stage, the construction schedule is as follows:

- Gallery closed for packing – 29 Jan 2017
- Artworks and gallery contents transferred to storage – 29 Jan to 6 Feb
- Construction starts – 7 Feb 2017
- Construction schedule – approx. 4-5 weeks
- Construction ends – approx 10 March 2017
- Gallery reopens – approx. 13 March 2017

In the week from 29 January – 6 February 2017 the committee will pack up and store all gallery contents in our storage container. The container is securely locked and water-proof, and is located within a secured yard in Darfield.

If you are happy for your artworks to be stored in the Gallery container, you do not need to do anything. If you wish to retrieve your artworks for private storage, please contact Rose Gerard, MCAC administrator, to organise a date to collect them.
